Caring **HEARTS** Journey helps children and young adults who have a life-limiting illness by managing emotional, spiritual, social, and physical needs of the patient and family members. The Caring **HEARTS** Journey team of medical social worker, chaplain, counselor, nurse, and palliative care physician works closely with the patient's attending physician to maximize quality of life for each patient and family.

Caring **HEARTS** Journey provides:

- Support — someone to listen — for patients, parents, and families
- Community referrals
- Assistance developing goals of care, based on emotional, spiritual, and physical needs of patient and family
- A liaison between patients, parents, and service providers
- Consultative visits with our palliative care physician and nurse, as needed

Caring HEARTS Journey offers to care for:
Children and young adults from birth to age 21
who have a life-limiting illness and their families.

How is Caring HEARTS Journey provided?

A medical social worker or chaplain will make home visits or contact you by phone. A palliative care physician and nurse are also available to visit, as needed.

Where is Caring HEARTS Journey provided?

- Private residence
- Hospitals located in Caldwell and surrounding counties

Payment

- Medicaid
- Most private insurance
- Services provided for all patients, regardless of ability to pay

Who can make a referral to Caring HEARTS Journey?

A physician's order is required before a child or young adult can receive the services of Caring **HEARTS** Journey. However, anyone can make a referral, and we will contact the patient's physician about the service.
