

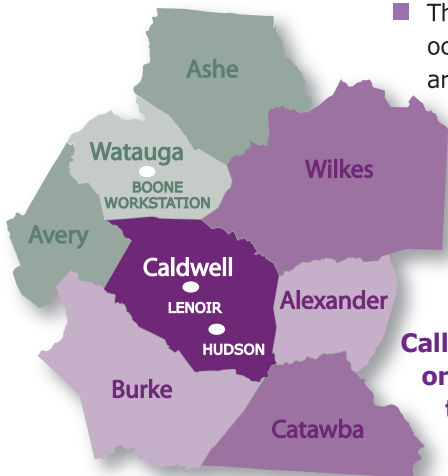

Palliative Medicine Services

AIM: Advanced Illness Management is a palliative medicine consultative service that provides an extra layer of support for anyone living with serious illness. Goals are to:

- optimize quality of life,
- prevent frequent hospitalizations, and
- empower patients and families in managing complex illnesses.

Care is provided in hospitals, long-term-care facilities, or private residences by a medical doctor, nurse practitioner or physician assistant.



AIM is a collaboration between Caldwell UNC Health Care and Caldwell Hospice and Palliative Care.

Hospice Services

Caldwell Hospice cares for patients in their own homes, long-term-care facilities, hospitals, or in one of our two patient care units.

Four Levels of Hospice Care:

- **Routine Home Care** is provided wherever you call home, including your private residence, skilled nursing facility, and assisted living facility.
- **General Inpatient Care** (GIP) is short-term, around-the-clock care provided in the hospital, skilled nursing facility, or in one of our two patient care units: *William E. Stevens, Jr.* in Lenoir and *Forlines* in Hudson, if you are experiencing a crisis.
- **Respite Care** is short-term care, up to five days, provided in the hospital, skilled nursing facility, or in one of our two patient care units, allowing the caregiver a break to attend to personal needs.
- **Residential Care** is available for hospice patients who do not have the option of receiving care at home. Residential services are provided in one of our two patient care units and similar to routine home care. Room-and-board fees do apply.

Hospice care is covered by Medicare/Medicaid and most private insurance companies. Caldwell Hospice provides services regardless of ability to pay.

Caldwell Hospice, the only not-for-profit hospice care provider in Caldwell County, provides expanded resources for you and your family. Caldwell Hospice is certified by Medicare and accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Health Care.
