Nature Trail and Creekside Patio at Robbins Center

Sometimes when a loved one is staying at our Forlines Patient Care Unit, family members need a quiet outdoors place to escape and reflect. Now, thanks to the work of a local Eagle Scout, the Robbins Center offers its Nature Trail and Creekside Patio.

Located on the east side of our campus, the quarter-mile trail is an easy walk through the woods surrounding the Robbins Center. It ends at a bend in the creek, where a table and patio area provide a place to rest or to enjoy a picnic.

Two white posts mark the trail entrance and hikers can follow the white posts along the trail to the patio. It is an easy walk with no steep grades and a foot bridge across the gully, we invite our guests to take a few minutes to enjoy the trail and patio.

Project History

"Do something you know is going to last."
That's the reason Daniel Osborne decided to build the Nature Trail and Creekside Patio on the campus of the Robbins Center as his Eagle Scout project.

Daniel approached Caldwell Hospice in Spring 2010 with his idea to build a trail at the Robbins Center. With permission from the Caldwell Hospice Board of Directors and approval from the local Boy Scout Council, Daniel began planning, gathering materials, and recruiting donors for the project. With the majority of materials donated, Daniel, and the volunteers he recruited began work in July 2010. In September, after 12 on-site work days, nearly 400 total hours, and the help of 70 volunteers, Daniel had completed his project and earned the rank of Eagle Scout.

Daniel, son of Craig and Sharon Osborne, was a junior at Hibriten High School at the time the project was completed.
